

Checklist

You should bring the following:

- ID card + important documents
- Cash/Debit card
- Medications
- Mobile phone, charging cable, and a charged power bank
- Clothing for the day
- Special food (if needed), diapers + baby supplies
- Possibly books/toys for children
- Pet food/poop bags (if needed)

Before you leave your apartment:


- Park your private vehicle outside the restricted zone
- Switch off electrical and gas appliances (stove, oven, iron)
- Extinguish candles and open flames
- Turn off the taps
- Tilt the window (as a precaution in case of a possible controlled demolition)
- Turn off lights, motion detectors, and timers for lighting (so that emergency personnel on patrol don't think someone is still in the house)

**Evacuation on Sunday,
April 26, 2026**

An unexploded World War II bomb has been found under the BHW parking lot on Springer Landstraße. The area is being evacuated to defuse it!

**You live in the evacuation zone and
must therefore leave your home and
the restricted area on April 26, 2026.
Leave by 7 a.m. at the latest!**

What do I have to do?



By 7 a.m.: Leave your home and the cordoned-off area. All buildings, streets, and squares in the evacuation zone will be closed from 7 a.m. The faster the area is evacuated, the sooner work can begin at the site and the sooner you can return to your home. Follow the instructions of the police, fire department, and public order office!



The evacuation zone will be controlled by the fire department and police during the operation. Everyone must leave the area. If you refuse, we will have to escort you from your home (if necessary, together with the police). This could result in substantial fines.



Please arrange accommodation outside the restricted area for the duration of the evacuation. If this is not possible, the city of Hameln offers emergency accommodation in the Rattenfängerhalle, Mühlenstraße 17.



Take advantage of the free shuttle buses that will run from the evacuation area to the Rattenfängerhalle between 5 and 7 a.m. on that day, or park for free in the Rattenfängerhalle underground car park.



Pets can remain in the apartment but may also be brought to the emergency shelter. However, they must be in transport crates in the hall and may only be taken outside on a leash for walks. Please remember to bring sufficient food and, if necessary, poop bags.



The Rattenfängerhalle provides basic meals and drinks.



The shuttle buses and the Rattenfängerhalle are barrier-free and can be used with wheelchairs, walkers and strollers.



The duration of the evacuation depends on the progress of the bomb disposal experts. As a precaution, you should expect to be able to return to your home only in the evening. Important: Returning to the evacuation area is only possible after the all-clear has been given and official permission has been granted!
